### ⇒ Drive down the other side of the pass


Nick's headache relieved.

Driver takes Nick to Darchin Medical College


- Given Tibetan medicine

Ans - The article has been titled 'Silk Road.'




arrived there in 1900 . He was so moved by the ~~sensity~~ sensitivity of the lake that he burst into tears

Ans - The purpose of the author's Journey to Mount Kailash was religious one. He had to perform Kavach to mount Kailash


2. The author's physical condition in Darchen
