 - Cyril is shocked at the sudden change in his mother's attitude

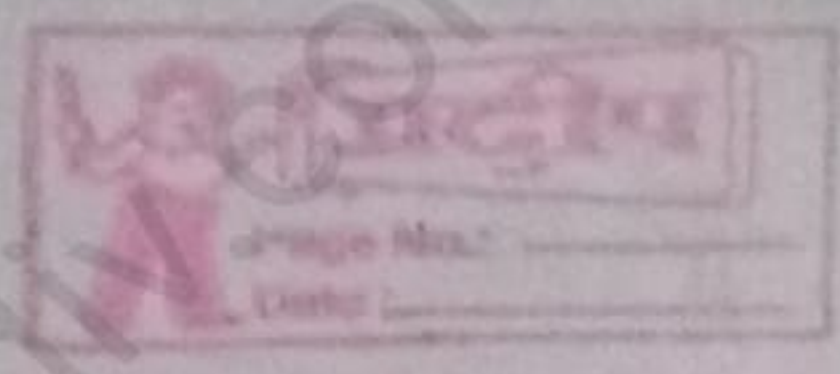
Doris and Cyril realised analyze their mother's changed behaviour.

• He loses her temper & start shouting at Mrs Pearson and creating a scene in front of her neighbour.

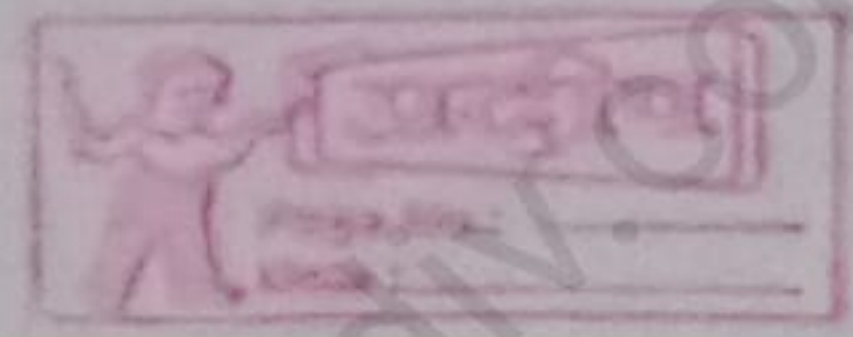
→ Mrs Fitzgerald and Mrs Pearson change back into their original personality
